

GROSS FAMILY of SWEDEN & MAINE

First Generation

1. Carl Ludvig Lorenz GROSS, son of **Carl Jacob GROSS**, was born 6 Jul 1823 in Berlin, Prussia, Germany and died 29 Dec 1889 in Berlin, Berlin, Germany.

Swedish family records: Dec 1854 Kristine Parish, Goteborg City Incoming membership of Carl Ludvig Lorenz Gross, a cloth printer from Berlin. Became Swedish citizen 1856. in OrgrYTE. "Family came from #35 in 1863."

Elsie (Bailey) Reeck book: Carl Gross was an engineer traveling to many European countries helping to set up new methods of machinery in factories. In the 1850s he came to Goteborg Sweden to set up a new process of machinery called the Piratia printer named after the Frenchman Pirrotin who invented this machine, which was able to print cloth for clothing with three colors in one step; it was developed in 1830. Elsie Reeck's book details pages and pages of our Swedish family history.

17 Feb 2014 I received an email from a cousin in Sweden who found my website, Sune Persson, husband of Elisabeth Ulfstrom. He supplied death date for Emilia Borjesson and families of some of their children, and says "So far in my research I have also found out that Carl Ludvig was married in Germany before he came to Sweden and after the death of Emilia Augusta in 1869, he went back to Germany in 1870 and there was married again in 1871."

1871 Marriage index record on "Deutschland Heiraten, 1558-1929," database, *FamilySearch* says father is Jacob Gross.

Carl married **Emilie Augusta Luise BROSSIN** 30 Jun 1844 in Berlin, Prussia, Germany. Emilie was born about 1823 in , , Germany and died before 1855 in Berlin, Prussia, Germany.

Carl next married **Emilia Augusta BÖRJESSON**, daughter of **Magnus BÖRJESSON** and **Anna SVENSDOTTER**, 18 Feb 1855 in Örgryte, G&B, Sweden. Emilia was born 10 Aug 1827 in Stom-Örgryte, G&B, Sweden and died 10 Mar 1869 in Göteborg, G&B, Sweden.

Bpt 19 Aug 1827 Örgryte. Emilia's granddaughter, Elsie Reeck's family history: The court house marriage records call Emilia a "Gotenborg beauty". "When my mother was still an infant, there was a plague in Sweden. My mother told me they called it "rose fever", no doubt like our scarlet fever. Her mother and father both died from it. No record I have has shown me the year that they died, but my mother says she was just a baby. My grandmother, Emilie Augusta Borgesson, had two maiden sisters who lived in Gotenborg, Britta and Hannah. They ran an inn or hostel, whatever they called it in that day. Travel was mostly by horseback or horse and carriage, and they took all the eight orphans into their home, educated them, and brought them up. As I have told you, the boys were musician, jeweler, and florist. The girls were taught homemaking, dress making, and millinery, all kinds of hand work, such as knitting and crocheting. My mother preferred millinery, but she was an excellent cook, dressmaker, and homemaker. See Elsie's story for much more family life.

1871 Mar index on Ancestry names fathers, b-dates: Div Mrs Linard, b 4 June 1841. Birth rec says 7 Feb 1841 as Wilhelmine Christiane.

2. **Julius Albert Fernandez GROSS** (*Carl Ludwig Lorenz*¹) was born 12 Apr 1846 in Berlin, Prussia, Germany and died in 1919 in Togus-Chelsea, Kennebec, ME.

Julius, Emma, Frederick, and Alice are all buried in Mt Hope Cem in Augusta. Served 3rd Reg US Army 1873-1878. "Uncle Julius" sponsored the Petersons when they came to America. They were taught to speak American by being ignored if they spoke Swedish. Julius was able to speak 5 languages. 1900 Augusta census says he was a musician and came to America in 1870 and was Naturalized, and also owned a farm. 1910 census has him and son as farmers, and he came to US in 1873. Julius died at Togus Hospital. 1880 census, seems to be in Helena, Lewis & Clarke Co, Montana, 34 musician, he and parents b Prussia. Birth date of Apr 1846 comes from 1900 census. Kristine Parish, Goteborg City index of Germans 1852-1883 lists Julius as born 14 Aug 1847 in Berlin. Another family record gives his birth as 12 Apr 1846.

Julius married **Emma Aurelia Augusta KOENIG**, daughter of **Adolph KOENIG** and **Emma HARMS**, 12 Oct 1882 in Boston, Suffolk, MA. Emma was born 4 Nov 1853 in Richmond, Chesterfield, VA and died 28 Aug 1918 in Augusta, Kennebec, ME.

D/C: Emma was a resident of Augusta 30 years, prev res Boston. She died of breast cancer. Her parents were Adolph Koenig & Emma Harms, both b Germany. Buried Augusta. 1900 Augusta census says she was b Nov 1853, age 46, M17, 1 ch. Death cert says she was born 4 Nov 1854.

Family remembers an "Uncle Gus Koenig" and we have a photo - probably a brother of Emma - check censuses. His death not found in Maine through 1955.

WWI draft registrations gives his full name and birth date, of RFD 2 Augusta, born Dresden, Maine, self-empl farmer in Augusta, takes care of his parents, single; tall height, medium build, blue eyes, brown hair. Elsie Reeck used to visit him in Portland. His M/C says he was b Chelsea, a commercial traveler, Alice a RN. Names parents; his parents b Berlin Germany & Richmond VA; hers b W Bridgewater & Brockton.

Frederic married **Alice Belle ALGER**, daughter of **Cyrus Elgin ALGER** and **Minnie Kingman GOULD**, 4 Sep 1921 in Augusta, Kennebec, ME. Alice was born 11 Aug 1894 in West Bridgewater, Plymouth, MA and died 10 Nov 1969 in Portland, Cumberland, ME.

3. **Johanna Malvinna GROSS** (*Carl Ludwig Lorenz*¹) was born 24 Jun 1855 in Örgryte, G&B, Sweden and died 7 Jan 1908 in Marstrand - Kungälv, Västra Götaland, Sweden.

Mtdna branch is U2e1a. Haplogroup U2 arose in the Near East about 45,000 years ago. U2e is one of the oldest haplogroups in Europe. It appears to have reached there with some of the continent's first modern human settlers about 35,000 years ago, at a time when Neanderthals were the only Europeans. By the time of the Neanderthals' extinction about 28,000 years ago, haplogroup U2e was probably distributed across much of Europe. But today, thanks to the subsequent arrival of many other haplogroups, it has become relatively rare. U2e reaches its highest levels in places like the town of Murlo, where many inhabitants are thought to be descended from the pre-Roman Etruscan people. It is also relatively common among the Udmurts and Mordvinians, who live in the Volga River drainage and Ural Mountain regions.

Johanna married **Karl Albert PETTERSSON**, son of **Henrik Johannesson PETTERSSON** and **Anna HOLMEN**, 22 Jan 1884 in Örgryte, G&B, Sweden. Karl was born 22 Sep 1858 in Marstrand - Kungälv, Västra Götaland, Sweden and died 10 Mar 1926 in Marstrand - Kungälv, Västra Götaland, Sweden.

They married and made their home on the island of Marstrand, outside Gotenborg. My grandmother Marion said on tape 1990, that Carl was a fisherman, maybe a captain. Henry and Agnes Pettersson (Peterson in the US) came to Maine 1903 in their teens, leaving Sweden 29 July 1903 on the ship Rollo, destination Grimsby. Erik left Sweden 31 March 1908 to Maine. Agnes stayed in Farmingdale Maine. We still have the large portraits of Agnes' parents Carl and Johanna, that she brought with her from Sweden. Henry and Erik went to Chicago and enlisted in WW I. Marie went direct from Sweden 22 Sept 1922 to Chicago. I found relatives of Josef in Sweden and they

also know nothing more about them. We also have photos of Erik and Henry. Karl & Johanna both had brown hair.

I have many ancestors of these families researched by SLC Swedish researcher Tim Vincent in the 1980s. My grandmother, Marion (Boudway) Rhoades (dau of Agnes), says that Henry, Agnes, and Erik came to Maine and were greeted here by their Uncle Julius Gross; Julius had a son Fred. Agnes did not know a word of English; she just had a name tag saying where she was going. Julius taught her (and the boys too, I presume) to speak English by ignoring her if she spoke Swedish. They also had two aunts who came to Maine. Hedwig Gross b 1857 m Gideon Pond. Emily Augusta Gross b 1867 came to the US in 1886 and married James Bailey. The Baileys have continued contact with the Gross family in Sweden and wrote a book.

The Carl Julius Gross family line chose to use his mothers, Maria Charlotta's, maiden name Gross for the family surname.

10. **Emily Augusta GROSS** (*Carl Ludvig Lorenz*¹) was born 18 May 1867 in Boras, Alvsborg, Sweden and died 12 May 1955 in Litchfield, Kennebec, ME.

Christened 16 June 1867. At age 19, Emily came to US, leaving 18 June 1886 on the ship Juno for Boston MA via Hull England. D/C says she was b 24 May 1867, but birth record in Sweden says 18 May 1867. Swedish aunts Anna and Brita Borjesson brought up Emelia (Emily) Augusta Gross and her siblings. Daughter Elsie still had the "Hembygod" hope chest trunk that Emily brought with her, in her attic in Houlton in 1950. See Elsie's family story for much more on family life.

About 1904, Emily was notified that she had been left an inheritance in Sweden from her Aunt's estate who had brought up all her brothers and sisters. To accept, you had to be there in person. So off she went with her 4-year-old son George. All the relatives came to meet her and they ended up staying for six months. When they were in Stockholm visiting Mother's sister Marie Johnson and family, Marie's husband was a banker, and I believe had a part in the Government as we were summoned to King Gustav's palace for meetings. He had a carriage and a span of horses to drive there, so thought he must take his little American nephew to meet the King. I think he must have been quite special as my Mother said they passed him around to even sit on the King's lap.

In the 1920s, Emily sponsored her Swedish nephew David Gross, son of her brother Magnus.

Emily married **James Warren BAILEY**, son of **James H BAILEY** and **Martha BRAWN**, 11 Oct 1899 in Augusta, Kennebec, ME. James was born 1 Mar 1835 in Somerville, Lincoln, ME and died 13 Sep 1908 in Togus-Chelsea, Kennebec, ME.

Donald was born 14 Jan 1911 in , , NY and died 1 Feb 1984 in St Petersburg, Pinellas, FL. They had no children.

12. Henrik Julius PETERSON (*Johanna Malvinna GROSS*², *Carl Ludwig Lorenz*¹) was born 16 Oct 1883 in Haga - Goteborg City, G&B, Sweden and died 24 Nov 1921 in Chicago, Cook, IL.

Address in Maria's songbook for Henry left behind in Sweden was 2728 Sheffield Ave, Chicago. However Maj Fihn in Sweden said that her mother's last letter to Maria in Chicago came back "addressee unknown". Note: I thought I had found Henry through the SSDI death index, with a Henry Peterson born the exact same day 16 Oct 1883 who died 23 June 1983 in CA, but it was no relation. Henry Julius Peterson registered for WWI Sep 12 1918 in Chicago. His address is as stated above, born Oct 16 1883, naturalized b Sweden, cabinet maker at Decker Bros, 1227 Miller in Chicago. Wife Hulda Peterson. He was medium height and build, blue eyes, brown hair. Not found at all in Ancestry census index.

Familysearch.org has the b/c for dau Helen in Chicago which gives Hulda's maiden name; Henry Peterson is a printer. No others found thru 1922. No M/C found. Familysearch does not have the image but has the 1921 death of Henry J Peterson in Chicago, wife Hulda, parents Carl Peterson & Hans [sic] Gross.

IL Deaths on familysearch.org has a Hulda Peterson, spouse Henry, d 30 Dec 1925 Chicago, b 18 Sep 1879 Sweden to Andreas Swanson & Johanna Johnson. Buried Rosehill Cem. Sounds like the correct one, but not proven.

13. Agnes Elizabeth PETERSON (*Johanna Malvinna GROSS*², *Carl Ludwig Lorenz*¹) was born 3 May 1888 in Marstrand - Kungälv, Västra Götaland, Sweden and died 30 Oct 1925 in Farmingdale, Kennebec, ME.

Agnes came to America in 1903 from Marstrand Sweden, sponsored by either her uncle Julius Gross or uncle Gus Koenig. We have photos of Gus. She didn't speak a word of English, and she was taught by being ignored unless she spoke English, even asking for food at the table. She was told, you are American now, you speak American.

I have a leather postcard of Boston Public Library sent in May 1906 to Miss Agnes Pettersson, 38 Pleasant St, Gardiner ME, by "Hattie". Nana/Marion said that Agnes lived in Gardiner (Lincoln Ave?) as a nanny/housekeeper for the Peasley family in Gardiner before marriage. She would often visit her Aunt Emily Gross Bailey. Elsie Reeck in her book says, Agnes loved to dance, so she met a nice man at one of the square dances in the Grange Hall and married him (Frank Boudway). So now both would come to the farm. They liked to play cards, whist and hearts.

They lived at 131 Northern Ave abt 1909-1926 where Nana was born; 1926-1933 they lived at 117 Northern Ave, now green just below Sheldon St. Lived at 133 since 1934.

I have their original oversize certificate of marriage, Frank's name mis-spelled as Bodway, at St Joseph's Catholic Church by Rev P H Reardon; witnesses Glenwood Lake & Margaret Elizabeth Pender.

I also have a book presented to Frank Boudway in 1944, "Commonwealth [Shoe Co] in Battle Dress", telling of the company's contributions of good shoes to the soldiers, and a thank you to the workers who made them. A ribbon in the book says "Frank Boudway * June 1899" which I believe would be when he started work there. Page 14 has a photo of Mary [Boudway] Dill in the Cutting Room; page 19 has a photo of Ida Boudway in the Fitting Room; page 30 has a photo of Flagg cousin Walter Rines and Frank Boudway in the Making Room. Page 63 honors employees in the Armed Services with their photo including Richard Boudway.

Obituary from July 11, 1968 Kennebec Journal:

Farmingdale '96 Frank E Boudway, 83, died at a Gardiner nursing home Wednesday following a long illness. He was born in Orono January 18, 1885, the son of John M and Mary Pooler Boudway. He was married to the late Agnes Peterson Boudway.

He was a former member of the Farmingdale Fire Department and Gardiner Lodge of Elks. Prior to his retirement in 1957, he was employed for 53 years at the Commonwealth Shoe and Leather Company.

He is survived by one son, Edward F Boudway of San Diego California; two daughters, Mrs. Dorothy Rankin of Pittston; and Mrs. Marion Rhoades of Farmingdale; eight grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren, and several nieces, nephews and cousins.

Marion said that Frank always worked in the shoeshop, working up to the heeling machine, and retired about age 78 without even a thankyou, and they also called him back to fill-in from time to time. Frank and Agnes picnic-ed on Pleasant Pond (Cobbosecontee), New Mills section of Gardiner. They played polo on roller skates. Agnes sewed all their clothes and dollclothes, and was a very neat housekeeper and a good cook, and made good hermits.

Frank seemed in perfect health into his 80s, when he was attending a high school football game and the bleachers collapsed. At the hospital when they opened him up, they found cancer and promptly closed him back up. He lived at home with Marion at 133 Northern Ave Farmingdale (83 after 911 changes), and his bed was brought downstairs to the living room until Marion just couldn't take care of him anymore and he went into a nursing home. That house was purchased in the early 1930s; previous residence was next door at 131, where Dot Boudway Rankin also lived. Frank's sister Arvilla Boudway Dill lived next door on the other side at 135. Frank/Gramp used to tell us kids Indian stories and sing the old Indian songs that his ancestors sang around the campfire. Then Nana/Marion would say, "Dad, stop making up those stories, we're not Indian." He was quite a character and over 40 years later, I still really miss him.

The newlyweds will live at 117 Northern Avenue, with Mrs Boudway's father.

It appears to have reached there with some of the continent's first modern human settlers about 35,000 years ago, at a time when Neanderthals were the only Europeans. By the time of the Neanderthals' extinction about 28,000 years ago, haplogroup U2e was probably distributed across much of Europe. But today, thanks to the subsequent arrival of many other haplogroups, it has become relatively rare. U2e reaches its highest levels in places like the town of Murlo, where many inhabitants

Roland and Marion are buried at Maine Avenue Cemetery, Farmingdale ME. Marion's memorial and story is at www.RolandRhoades.com/nana.htm. Roland was a member of the Pipefitters Union, traveling to many places for work. Being a union member, the family has always been strongly Democratic politically. Worked at Bath Iron Works, and helped build the St Lawrence Seaway in NY in the 1950s or 1960s. While at BIW, someone came up to him and said I think I know your sister. He replied, I don't have a sister. This was when he first learned that he did have a half-sister via his father's first marriage, Irma Rhoades Wall Butler. She visited and a group family photo is on my Rhoades family webpage. His father died when he was less than 2 years old. Roland was named after Thomas Edison because his father had worked with and thought highly of him. Roland was also a member of the Freemasons, though I don't recall him ever mentioning it; The Maine Mason magazine just kept coming in the mail. He loved to eat and would have spaghetti eating contests with the Boudway side of the family (Butch Nuzzo). He and Marion bought their house at 133 Northern Avenue Farmingdale [83 after 911 change] around 1933 and lived there their whole lives, until Marion sold it in 2003.

I remember that their phone # when I was a kid was simply "768M", a party line that was frequently being used by a neighbor when you wanted to use it.

My grandfather Roland in a 1990 tape said that he went back and forth from his mother's to his grandmother's and Uncle John's homes. Quit school at 14 to work. Lots of different schools. Remembers an Uncle Lent, and an Uncle Eanus who carved stuff, even wooden chains.
